

Meds Round – Controlled Drugs

Controlled drugs are administered directly to the resident and never 'Prepared' or 'Left in cup'



Click on the Meds Round icon.



Select the appropriate resident.



The controlled drug (e.g.: Morphine) is recognised easily by the exclamation mark in the yellow triangle.



When you select the controlled drug, a yellow background will appear behind the barcode scanning request to indicate a controlled drug is being administered. Scan the medication as usual. The yellow background will remain for the medication administration window.

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Click on the relevant icon.



Add any comments if necessary and click on **Save**.



A second sign in is required to confirm the medication has been administered.



Multiple medications cannot be prepared whilst there is a controlled drug in the 'cup'.

The Care Home can request that eMAR allow the preparation of more than one controlled drug for a single resident at a time.

Keep in mind as with the default setting, this request will not allow for controlled and non-controlled drugs to be prepared at the same time.

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
